<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Black tailored trousers or a knee length black skirt (suit material) Trousers/Skirts are not to be made of stretch material/cling to the leg ● White shirt (no frills and must be long enough to be tucked in to the skirt or trousers) short or long sleeve acceptable ● Black V neck jumpers with the SOA logo are permitted under the blazer ● House tie ● Shire Oak Academy blazer (with logo) Blazers should be worn to and from school and at all times during the school day. ● White or black socks ● Black school shoes (no trainers/boots/pumps) ● Coats: warm coats are advised. Jewellery:

Pupils are allowed to wear one pair of small studs and a wristwatch (Apple watches and similar items are not permitted). Other than this, they are not allowed jewellery (no additional earrings/ no bracelets/rings/necklaces). This is primarily for the safety of the students but also to avoid upset when items are lost - please ensure that jewellery is left safely at home. No other facial or body jewellery is allowed.

Make-up:

Year 7/8/9: No make-up, no nail varnish or false nails or eyelashes are permitted.

KS4: Girls may wear a sensible amount of makeup, but no nail varnish, false nails or false eyelashes. Students wearing make-up and/or nail varnish will be asked to remove it.

Hair – No extreme hairstyles - no shaved patterns and no unnatural hair colours

PE kit:

It is expected that all students participating in Physical Education wear the correct school kit as specified below.

2021/2022 permitted footwear types - shoes



As a general rule, boys' shoes have between 2 and 4 lace holes on each side. They often have some sort of defined heel. All of the above will be deemed as ACCEPTABLE from September.



As a general rule, girls' shoes have some sort of defined heel. All of the above will be deemed as ACCEPTABLE from September.

2021/2022 **NOT** permitted footwear types



NONE of the above will be acceptable in September. These are trainer/trainer style or boots. They have generally flat bottoms, more than 4 lace holes on each side or velcro.
